

NOTICE OF INFORMAL STAKEHOLDER MEETING RE: DRAFT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

Purpose:

The Taxpayer Transparency and Fairness Act of 2017 (Act) restructured the State Board of Equalization (BOE) and separated its functions among three entities to guarantee impartiality, equity, and efficiency in tax appeals, protect civil service employees, ensure fair tax collection statewide, and uphold the California Taxpayers' Bill of Rights. These three entities are the BOE, Office of Tax Appeals (OTA), and California Department of Tax and Fee Administration.

The OTA was established by the Act on July 1, 2017 and, beginning January 1, 2018, will be conducting appeals on taxes and fees that were previously conducted by the BOE, such as appeals on franchise and personal income tax, sales and use tax, and other special taxes and fees. The OTA is independent of any state taxing authority.

The Act requires the OTA to adopt regulations to govern its appeals processes and procedures prior to January 1, 2018.

At this informal stakeholder meeting, which will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end no later than 1:00 p.m., OTA staff will solicit input regarding the draft emergency regulations. This meeting is not part of the Administrative Procedure Act (APA) formal rulemaking process. Decisions will not be made at this meeting regarding changes to the emergency regulations, and any comments and input provided, written and/or oral, will not be responded to in writing. However, OTA staff will take under consideration any comments submitted regarding the draft emergency regulations, and will thereafter finalize and formally commence the APA emergency regulations rulemaking process.

Important: Please call the teleconference from a land-line using the telephone handset only. This enhances the ability to hear your comments clearly. Calling from a speaker phone or a cell phone reduces the quality of the audio and makes it much harder for your comments to be heard clearly.
