### **Topic:**

The Taxpayer Transparency and Fairness Act of 2017 authorized the establishment of the Office of Tax Appeals (OTA) with jurisdiction over tax appeals beginning January 1, 2018. In order to carry out its duties, powers and responsibilities, the OTA adopted and readopted emergency regulations pursuant to Government Code section 15679 for the period January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018. New regulations are required for the OTA to continue to carry out its duties, powers, and responsibilities following the expiration of the current emergency regulations. Previously, OTA issued a draft and a revised draft of the proposed new regulations, and held two informal interested parties meetings on April 16, 2018 and June 6, 2018. Subsequently, OTA initiated the formal rulemaking process, with a public comment period that will close on August 27, 2018.

Considering the importance of the new proposed regulations and to ensure transparency, OTA will hold this public hearing on the proposed regulations pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8.
