The Office of Tax Appeals (OTA) will hold an interested parties meeting to discuss proposed amendments to its Rules for Tax Appeals.

Background:

The Rules for Tax Appeals govern the administrative review processes for all appeals and related claims for reimbursement of fees and expenses filed with OTA. Recently adopted legislation made some changes to the laws governing OTA. (See Senate Bill 189, Stats. 2022, Ch. 48.) In addition, OTA proposes making miscellaneous comprehensive cleanup amendments to the Rules for Tax Appeals. OTA invites interested parties to submit comments and/or suggested language changes or additions in the form of alternative text by the comment deadline.

Public Meeting: This meeting will be held virtually and will also be livestreamed on OTA’s YouTube channel.¹ All written and oral comments will be considered. Whether or not you are able to participate in the interested parties meeting, you may submit comments for consideration by the comment deadline.
